

## God's Voice To The Nation – Jamaica Jamaica Mercy Cry - 2013

**Psalm 2:1-12 (NLT)** <sup>1</sup> Why are the nations so angry? Why do they waste their time with futile plans? <sup>2</sup> The kings of the earth prepare for battle; the rulers plot together against the LORD and against his anointed one. <sup>3</sup> “Let us break their chains,” they cry, “and free ourselves from slavery to God.” <sup>4</sup> But the one who rules in heaven laughs. The Lord scoffs at them. <sup>5</sup> Then in anger he rebukes them, terrifying them with his fierce fury. <sup>6</sup> For the Lord declares, “I have placed my chosen king on the throne in Jerusalem, on my holy mountain.” <sup>7</sup> The king proclaims the LORD’s decree: “The LORD said to me, ‘You are my son. Today I have become your Father. <sup>8</sup> Only ask, and I will give you the nations as your inheritance, the whole earth as your possession. <sup>9</sup> You will break them with an iron rod and smash them like clay pots.’” <sup>10</sup> Now then, you kings, act wisely! Be warned, you rulers of the earth! <sup>11</sup> Serve the LORD with reverent fear, and rejoice with trembling. <sup>12</sup> Submit to God’s royal son, or he will become angry, and you will be destroyed in the midst of all your activities— for his anger flares up in an instant. But what joy for all who take refuge in him!

**Proverbs 14:34 (KJV)** Righteousness exalteth a nation: but sin is a reproach to any people.

**Joshua 1:8 (KJV)** This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

**Proverbs 11:6 (KJV)** The righteousness of the upright shall deliver them: but transgressors shall be taken in *their own* naughtiness.

**Proverbs 11:10-11 (KJV)** When it goeth well with the righteous, the city rejoiceth: and when the wicked perish, *there is* shouting. By the blessing of the upright the city is exalted: but it is overthrown by the mouth of the wicked.

**Psalm 144:1-8 (NLT)** Praise the LORD, who is my rock. He trains my hands for war and gives my fingers skill for battle. <sup>2</sup> He is my loving ally and my fortress, my tower of safety, my rescuer. He is my shield, and I take refuge in him. He makes the nations submit to me. <sup>3</sup> O LORD, who are we that you should notice us, mere mortals that you should care for us? <sup>4</sup> For we are like a breath of air; our days are like a passing shadow. <sup>5</sup> Open the heavens, LORD, and come down. Touch the mountains so they billow smoke.

<sup>6</sup> Hurl your lightning bolts and scatter your enemies! Shoot your arrows and confuse them! <sup>7</sup> Reach down from heaven and rescue me; rescue me from deep waters, from the power of my enemies. <sup>8</sup> Their mouths are full of lies; they swear to tell the truth, but they lie instead.

**Psalm 144:11-15 (NLT)** Save me! Rescue me from the power of my enemies. Their mouths are full of lies; they swear to tell the truth, but they lie instead.

<sup>12</sup> May our sons flourish in their youth like well-nurtured plants. May our daughters be like graceful pillars, carved to beautify a palace.

<sup>13</sup> May our barns be filled with crops of every kind. May the flocks in our fields multiply by the thousands, even tens of thousands,

<sup>14</sup> and may our oxen be loaded down with produce. May there be no enemy breaking through our walls, no going into captivity, no cries of alarm in our town squares.

<sup>15</sup> Yes, joyful are those who live like this! Joyful indeed are those whose God is the LORD.

## A call to the Prayer Warriors

In our rapidly changing times, people are desperate to know the future. Barely are we able to adjust to the last wave of changes when totally new realities explode into our nation.

Because of the increase fears spawned by change, our society has been inundated by a plethora of occult and demonic sources and forces -- fortune-tellers, astrologers, psychic hotlines; witchcraft; Satanists; African spirits; Islamic demands; gay-rights voices and monies; human rights influencers -- all pretending to be able to peek into the mystery of tomorrow.

Jesus offered His disciples a solution and now **Christ asks us to pray for God's kingdom to manifest itself in our world today.**

What do you think tomorrow would look like if God were to answer our prayers today?

What we see in the life and power of Jesus Christ is a faith picture of God's kingdom.

Jesus said that we can have that same full manifestation. The fact is, He actually commanded us to pray for Heaven's release on our earth!

Paul wrote, "I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you may know

1. what is the hope of His calling, 2. what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in

the saints, and 3. What is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe.

These are in accordance with the working of the strength of His might" ([Eph. 1:18-19](#)).

As a Christian, there is a power within you that is greater than great: it is called the

**"surpassing greatness of His power."** It is not human power but the actual "strength of HIS/JESUS' might." God demonstrated this "power toward us who believe" first "in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places" ([Eph. 1:19-20](#)).

The power of God's might is His resurrection power. **What does *resurrection* mean? It means that things that look dead, smell dead and act dead can be touched by God and raised to life!**

Now think about it: The resurrection power God has given us is of the same potency He demonstrated when He raised Jesus from the grave. Right now, because the strength and authority of God Almighty is attached to our prayer lives, we can look on things that are absolutely dead and pray forth eternal *life!*

**Our mission is to bring resurrection life to situations that are dead in this country. Whenever the devil challenges you in prayer, remind him that you are seated with the risen Christ "far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come" ([Eph. 1:21](#)). Christ's authority is final. Not only did the Father put "all things in subjection under His feet," He also "gave Him as head over all things to the church, which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all" ([Eph. 1:22-23](#)).**

**This is a most profound revelation of our role: What the our Leader the Lord Jesus Christ has attained, we the feet of the church should walk out. It means, God has positioned the church as the living bridge between the terrible conditions in this nation and the wonderful solutions from Heaven!**

As we submit to the Word and persevere in prayer, the future is changed and comes in alignment to God's will and purpose.

Most of the things we desire in prayer, requires that we persevere to have the desired result.

As **Prayer warriors we are the most powerful, demon-chasing, transformational Catalytic leaders, and world-moving beings on earth.** We never wonder about the future because we must become very busy creating it. **Prayer warriors are positioned by God to stand in faith for our families, churches, cities and nation.**

**Prayer is stronger than every king and mightier than any army. Prayer is the most powerful force on earth.** **Prayer secures us in God's strength for all our battles.**

[Luke 21:36](#) tells us to "Watch therefore and pray always" that you may have strength to **stand before the Son of Man.**" This is a **position of anointed authority and commissioning.** Elijah stood before God as did Gabriel ([1 Kings 17:1](#); [Luke 1:19](#)). **One who stands before God is a servant/attendant to the Almighty. When that one decrees God's Word, it comes to pass.**

**God has called us to be a prayer warrior,** **Christ is in you, and He ever lives to make intercession.** Look around at the landscape of life; **God wants you to release, through prayer, His future for every need you see.** **He shows you what is wrong so you can pray for things to be made right.**

The Lord our God in the midst of us is powerful. Our weapons are mighty through God to pull down strongholds.

*PRAYER: Lord Jesus, You said that the armies in Heaven follow You, and Your name is called "the Word of God." Help me to not only believe Your Word, but pray it in the power of the Holy Spirit! I accept that You have called me to be a prayer warrior. By Your grace, I receive a new anointing in intercession. Amen!*

[Ezek 37:1-28](#) NLT The LORD **took hold of me**, and I was **carried away by the Spirit of the LORD** to a valley filled with bones. <sup>2</sup> **He led me all around** among the bones that covered the valley floor. They were scattered everywhere across the ground and were completely dried out. <sup>3</sup> Then **he asked me**, "Son of man, can these bones become living people again?" "O Sovereign LORD," **I replied**, "you alone know the answer to that." <sup>4</sup> Then he said to me, **Speak a prophetic message to these bones and say**, Dry bones, **listen to the word of the LORD!** <sup>5</sup> This is what the Sovereign LORD says: Look! **I am going to put breath into you and**

make you live again! <sup>6</sup> I will put flesh and muscles on you and cover you with skin. I will put breath into you, and you will come to life. Then you will know that I am the LORD.” <sup>7</sup> So I spoke this message, just as he told me. Suddenly as I spoke, there was a rattling noise all across the valley. The bones of each body came together and attached themselves as complete skeletons. <sup>8</sup> Then as I watched, muscles and flesh formed over the bones. Then skin formed to cover their bodies, but they still had no breath in them. <sup>9</sup> Then he said to me:

Speak a prophetic message to the winds, son of man.

Speak a prophetic message and say, ‘This is what the Sovereign LORD says: **Come, O breath, from the four winds! Breathe into these dead bodies so they may live again.**’” <sup>10</sup> So I spoke the message as he commanded me, and breath came into their bodies. They all came to life and stood up on their feet—**a great army.**

<sup>11</sup> Then he said to me, “Son of man, these bones represent the people of Israel, (JAMAICA). They are saying, ‘We have become old, dry bones—all hope is gone. Our nation is finished.’” <sup>12</sup> Therefore,

Prophecy to them and say, this is what the Sovereign LORD says: **O my people, I will open your graves of exile and cause you to rise again. Then I will bring you back to the land of Israel.** <sup>13</sup> When this happens, O my people, you will know that I am the LORD. <sup>14</sup> I will put my Spirit in you, and you will live again and return home to your own land. Then you will know that I, the LORD, have spoken, and I have done what I said. Yes, the LORD has spoken!” <sup>15</sup>

Again a message came to me from the LORD: <sup>16</sup> “Son of man, **take a piece of wood and carve on it these words:** ‘This represents Judah and its allied tribes.’ Then **take another piece and carve these words on it:** ‘This represents Ephraim and the northern tribes of Israel.’

<sup>17</sup> **now hold them together in your hand as if they were one piece of wood.** <sup>18</sup> **When your people ask you what your actions mean,** <sup>19</sup> **say to them, ‘this is what the Sovereign LORD says: I will take Ephraim and the northern tribes and join them to Judah. I will make them one piece of wood in my hand.’** <sup>20</sup> **“Then hold out the pieces of wood you have inscribed, so the people can see them.** <sup>21</sup> **And give them this message from the Sovereign LORD: I will**

*gather the people of Israel from among the nations. I will bring them home to their own land from the places where they have been scattered.* <sup>22</sup> **I will unify them into one nation** on the mountains of Israel. **One king will rule them all; no longer will they be divided into two nations or into two kingdoms.**

**A. They will never again pollute themselves with their idols and vile images and rebellion, for I will save them from their sinful backsliding.**

**B. I will cleanse them. Then they will truly be my people, and I will be their God.** <sup>24</sup> “My servant David will be their king, and they will have only one shepherd.

**C. They will obey my regulations and be careful to keep my decrees.** <sup>25</sup> They will live in the land I gave my servant Jacob, the land where their ancestors lived. They and their children and their grandchildren after them will live there forever, generation after generation. And my servant David will be their prince forever.

**D. And I will make a covenant of peace with them, an everlasting covenant. I will give them their land and increase their numbers, and I will put my Temple among them forever.** <sup>27</sup> I will make my home among them. **I will be their God, and they will be my people.** <sup>28</sup> **And when my Temple is among them forever, the nations will know that I am the LORD, who makes Israel holy.” (JAMAICA HOLY)**

## **STEPS TO THE HEALING THE LAND**

1. Agreeing to the true nature of the sin with honesty and no justification
2. Accepting ownership of the sin and then deciding to turn from that sin
3. Forgiving everyone involved in the origins of that sin (“the roots”)
4. Confessing the sin before God
5. Receiving forgiveness
6. Being willing to forgive ourselves
7. Renouncing the negative characteristic of that sin
8. Choosing the way of righteousness
